Function Keys

- CLEAR Clears an entry.
- MENU Returns to the menu screen.

Cred) No function.

- **(green)** No function.
- (yellow) No function.
 - **(blue)** No function.
- CARD Exits the selected book.
- ON/OFF Turns BOOKMAN on or off.

Understanding the Color Keys

The color keys (red, green, yellow, and blue) perform the functions listed above only for the BOOKMAN book described in this User's Guide. The color keys for this product do not have any function.

Other books have their own color key functions, which are labelled on their cartridges and listed in their User's Guides. Read "Using the Color Keys" in other BOOKMAN products for more information.

Other Keys

- BACK Backs up or erases letters.
- ENTER Selects a menu item.
 - HELP Shows help messages.
- SPACE Pages down.
 - ?* Shows full menu name.

Direction Keys



Move in indicated direction.

Pages up or down.

Star Key Combinations*

- ★ + ♥ From within a stock entry, goes to the next stock entry.
- ☆ + → From within a stock entry, goes to the previous stock entry.

*Hold 🖾 while pressing the other key.

Warning: Never install or remove a cartridge when BOOKMAN is on. If you do, information that you entered in its built-in book, and in an installed cartridge, will be erased.

- 1. Turn BOOKMAN off.
- 2. Turn BOOKMAN over.
- 3. Align the tabs on the cartridge with the notches in the slot.



4. Press the cartridge down until it snaps into place.

Removing Cartridges

Warning: When you remove a cartridge to install another, information that you entered into the removed cartridge will be erased.

Once you have installed a cartridge in your BOOKMAN, you must select which book you want to use.

- 1. Turn BOOKMAN on.
- 2. Press CARD.



These are sample books.

3. Press ⊐ or (⊐ to highlight the book you want to use.



4. Press ENTER to select it.

About Screen Illustrations

Some screen illustrations in this User's Guide may differ from what you see on the actual screen. This does not mean that your BOOK-MAN is malfunctioning.

Changing Settings

You can adjust both the font and the screen contrast. The font changes the number of lines of text that appear on screen. The screen contrast determines how dark the screen appears.

- 1. Press CLEAR).
- 2. Press ▷ twice to highlight the Other menu.
- 3. Press 介 or ↓ to highlight Select Font or Set Contrast.



- 4. Press ENTER).
- 5. Highlight a setting.

Or press \hat{T} or \mathcal{J} if you selected Set Contrast.

To exit without changing settings, press (BACK).

- 6. Press ENTER to select the setting.
- 7. Press (CLEAR) when done.

Viewing a Demonstration

This product comes equipped with a brief demonstration which shows the features of this product and how to use them.

- 1. Press 与 twice to highlight the Other menu.
- 2. Press \downarrow to highlight *View Demo*.
- 3. Press ENTER.
- 4. Press **CLEAR** at any time to stop the demonstration.

➤ Help is Always at Hand

You can view a help message at virtually any screen by pressing (HELP). Press the direction keys to read it. To exit help, press (BACK).

► Follow the Arrows

The flashing arrows on the right of the screen show which arrow keys you can press to move around menus or view more text.

Searching by Ticker Symbol

If you know a stock's ticker symbol, you can find the stock's name and the exchange that it is traded on. To search by a ticker symbol do the following.

1. Press CLEAR).



2. Type the letters of the desired ticker symbol, until it is highlighted (e.g., *FEP*).



To erase letters press (BACK).

3. Press ENTER.

Press (MENU) to return to the Symbol menu.

5. Press (CLEAR) when done.

Finding a Ticker Symbol

> Understanding Stock Entries

In each stock entry there are always three pieces of information pertaining to the stock: the stock's ticker symbol (e.g., *FEP*), the name of the stock (e.g., *Franklin Electronic Pub. Inc.*), and the exchange that it is traded on (*AMEX*, *NASDAQ*, or *NYSD*. The name of the stock may also show whether or not the stock is preferred or is a warrant, as well as showing the stock's series, if it applies.

Moving between Menu Items

From within a stock entry, you can hold and press to go to the next stock entry, or hold and press to go to the previous one.

Searching by the Stock Name

- You can also search by the stock's name.
- 1. Press CLEAR).
- 2. Highlight the Name menu.
- 3. Type the letters of the desired stock name, until it is highlighted (e.g., *Franklin Electronic Pub. Inc.).*



To erase letters press (BACK)

- 4. Press ENTER.
- 5. Press 🏠 or 🗘 to read.
- 6. Press (CLEAR) when done.
- > Another Way to Search

You can also search for stock names by typing the first few letters of the stock name; then press \clubsuit to move down until the product you want is highlighted.

Viewing Full Menu Items

Some menu items are followed by ellipses (...) because they are too long to fit on one line. Press (?*) to view the full menu item.

Cartridge Care

• Do not touch the metal contacts on the cartridges.

Caution: Touching these electrical contacts with statically charged objects, including your fingers, could erase information entered in a cartridge or built-in book.



• Do not put excessive pressure on the cartridges.





 Do not expose the cartridges to heat, cold, or liquids.





If the BOOKMAN keyboard fails to respond, or if its screen performs erratically, first press (CLEAR) and then press (CNVOFF) twice. If nothing happens, follow the steps below to reset it.

Warning: Pressing the reset button with more than very light pressure may permanently disable your BOOKMAN. In addition, resetting BOOKMAN erases settings and information entered into its built-in book, and in an installed cartridge.

- **1. Hold** (CLEAR) and press (N/OFF). If nothing happens, try Step 2.
- 2. Use a paper clip to *gently* press BOOKMAN's reset button.
 - If your BOOKMAN has one cartridge slot, look for the recessed pinsized hole on the battery cover or near the cartridge slot.
 - If your BOOKMAN has two cartridge slots, the reset button is located on the front of the unit next to (NOFF).



AC adaptor jack: Your BOOKMAN may be equipped with a standard 3.5 mm jack for use with a 9-volt, 200-300 milliamp AC/DC adaptor.



This symbol indicates that the inner core of the plug of an AC adaptor is negative and that the outer part of the plug is positive. If your AC/DC adaptor does not have this symbol, confirm its compatibility at its place of purchase.
