Throughout this User's Manual you will see tips like this about how to get the most from your Spanish Master. Look for them.

## Key Guide

---

-  Clears a search.
-  Shows the main menus.
-  Shows the games menu.
-  Shows inflected forms of words.
-  Shows User List options.
-  Speaks an English or Spanish word.
-  Exits the digital book.
-  Turns the Digital Book System on or off.
-  Goes back a step, erases a letter.
-  Enters a request, selects a menu item.
-  Displays a help message.
-  Shifts the keyboard to capital letters.
-  Types a question mark; shifted, an asterisk; in menus, shows a complete item.
-   Scrolls up or down.
-  Goes back a space.
-  Moves around the screen.
- UP or DN Pages up or down, finds next or previous entry alphabetically with the  key.
-  Zooms up or down with arrow keys, goes to previous or next entry with UP or DN, sends words between digital books with .

# Getting Started

## Installing the Digital Book

*You must first install the Spanish Master digital book before you can use it. WARNING: Never install a digital book when the Digital Book System is turned on.*

1. Turn the Digital Book System off.
2. Install the digital book into a slot on the back.
3. Press **ON/OFF**.
4. Turn the wheel on the side of the Digital Book System to adjust the screen contrast.  
If the screen is still blank, check the batteries.
5. Press **CARD**.
6. Press **←** or **→** to highlight the appropriate digital book symbol.



7. Press **ENTER**.

If you speak English, press **A**.  
Si hablas español, pulsa **B**.

8. Press A for English or B for Spanish.

### Using the Menus

The menu key is a toggle key that will take you back and forth between the menus and an entry screen. Press **MENU** to move back and forth between screens. The arrow keys located at the bottom right of your Digital Book System are your primary means of moving around the screens. Notice also the UP and DN keys. These keys are used to move down a list or definition screen by screen.

### Tutorial

If you need a portable reminder of what each key does, highlight "Tutorial" under the Other menu and then press **ENTER**. The tutorial explains the functions of the keys.

#### ✓ Help Is Always at Hand

- You can view an appropriate help message at any time by pressing **HELP**.
- To exit a help message, press **BACK**.
- To scroll up or down, press **↑** or **↓**.
- To page up press UP. To page down, press DN or **SPACE**.
- To go to the start or to the end of a message or list, hold **○** and press **↑** or **↓**.

## Getting Started

---

### Viewing a Demonstration

*Before you start using this product, you might want to view a brief demonstration of what it can do.*

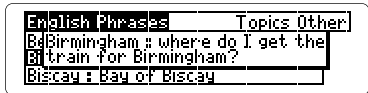
1. Press **MENU**.
2. Highlight "Demo" under the Other menu.



3. Press **ENTER** to start the demonstration.
4. Press **CLEAR** to stop the demonstration.

#### ✓ Viewing Complete Menu Items

Some items are too long to fit on menus. If you see a menu item followed by ellipses, press **?\*** to view the complete item.





### Setting the Shutoff Time

*Your Digital Book System has the ability to shut itself off if no key is pressed in a certain amount of time, determined by you. This ensures longer life for your batteries.*

1. Highlight **“Set Shutoff”** under the **Other** menu.
2. Press **ENTER** to select it.
3. Press **↓** to highlight a time.
4. Press **ENTER** to select it.

### Changing the Message Language

*The first time you use the Spanish Master, you must select the message language. Here is how to change your selection. NOTE: The message language is the language in which the menus and messages appear. Normally, you should select your native language.*

1. Highlight **“Message Language”** under the **Other** menu.
2. Press **ENTER** to select it.  
The message language is changed.
3. Press **ENTER** again to change it back.

# Using the Dictionary

## English to Spanish

*Here is how to enter an English word to find its Spanish definition(s).*

1. Highlight “English Spanish” under the Topics menu.

2. Press **ENTER** to select it.

3. Type “house”.

4. Press **ENTER**.

“Multiple forms” appears.

5. Press **↓** to highlight “house.”

6. Press **ENTER** to select it.

7. Press **↓** to scroll down.

You see the definitions of the word you entered and of related words and phrases.

8. Press **CLEAR** when done.

### ✓ Understanding Brackets

In definitions, words in brackets indicate specialized usages.

### ✓ Following the Arrows

The blinking arrows at the bottom of the screen show which arrow keys you can press to move around menus and other screens.

## Using the Dictionary

---

### Spanish to English

To find the English definition(s) of a Spanish word, follow this example.

**1. Select “Spanish English” under the Topics menu.**

“ENTER a word in Spanish” appears.

**2. Type “verde”.**

**3. Press .**

```
verde (adjective):  
green  
[chiste]: blue, dirty  
verde (masculine noun):  
green
```

**4. Press  to scroll down.**

**5. Press  when done.**

#### ✓ Viewing Next and Previous Words

To view the dictionary word listed alphabetically before the one you entered, hold  and press the UP key. To view the word listed alphabetically after the one you entered, hold  and press the DN key.

### English Phrases

*The Spanish Master is equipped with a special feature that allows you to find English and Spanish phrases. Instead of putting together several words and trying to come up with the meaning as a whole, you have the phrases right at your fingertips.*

**1. Select “English Phrases” under the Topics menu.**

“ENTER a word in an English phrase” appears.

**2. Type “year”.**

**3. Press **ENTER**.**

**5. Press **CLEAR** when done.**

### Spanish Phrases

1. Select “Spanish Phrases” under the Topics menu.


“ENTER a word in a Spanish phrase” appears.

2. Type “estados”.
3. Press **ENTER**.
4. Press **↓** to highlight “estados.”

5. Press **ENTER** again to select it.

**estado civil:** ↓

6. Press **↓** to scroll down.
7. Press **CLEAR** when done.

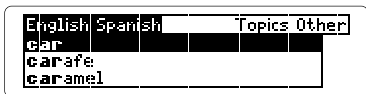
## Using the Dictionary

### ✓ Searching the Menus

You can find a Spanish or English word or phrase without having to type it at an Entry screen. First, if the main menus are not in view, press **(MENU)**. An alphabetic list of words under a dictionary menu appears at the left of the screen.



Next, start typing a word (e.g., "car"). As you type, words are highlighted. Usually you need to type only a few letters to highlight the word that you want.



Once the word is highlighted, press **(ENTER)** to view its definition(s).

**NOTE:** You can search the menus at the far left of the screen when any of the four dictionaries is selected.

### Defining Words in Definitions

*You can look up the definition of a word used in a definition without having to retype it at an Entry screen.*

1. Select “English Spanish”  
under the Topics menu.

2. Type “ground”.


3. Press **ENTER**.

4. Press **ENTER** again.

Notice that “ground” is highlighted.

5. Press **↓** to highlight “suelo.”

6. Press **ENTER** to view its definition.



suelo (masculine noun):  
[tierra]: ground  
[de casa]: floor

7. Press **BACK** to return to the first definition.

8. Press **BACK** again to remove the highlight.

9. Press **CLEAR** when done.

### Hearing Words

*If you have a Digital Book System that can play audio digital books, you can use the Spanish Master to hear the pronunciation of both English and Spanish words.*

*You can hear pronunciations before entering a word, after entering it, or by highlighting a word in a definition. You can also hear words in a User List, spelling correction lists, and dictionary lists.*

**1. Type “fish” at “ENTER a word in English.”**

**2. Press **SPEC** or **SAY**.**

You hear the pronunciation of “fish.” Turn the wheel on the side of the Digital Book System to adjust the volume.

**3. Press **ENTER** to view its definitions.**

**4. Press **SPEC** or **SAY**.**

You hear “fish” again.

**5. Press **ENTER** to start the highlight.**

**6. Press the arrow keys to highlight “pescado.”**

**7. Press **SPEC** or **SAY** to hear “pescado.”**

**8. Press **CLEAR** when done.**



### Correcting Misspellings

*Don't worry if you misspell a Spanish or English word. The Spanish Master will automatically provide a list of spelling corrections. Make sure you're at the Spanish Entry screen for this example.*


1. Type "roho" at "ENTER a word in Spanish."
2. Press **ENTER**.



roho  
robo  
rojo  
romo  
roto

This is a list of spelling corrections.

3. Press **↓** to highlight "rojo."
4. Press **ENTER** to view its definitions.



**rojo**, a (adjective, masc noun):  
red  
**al rojo vivo**:  
red-hot

5. Press **CLEAR** when done.

## Using the Dictionary

---

### Finding Letters in Words

*The question mark key is used when you know how many letters a word has, but don't know how to spell it. Type a “?” in place of each letter you don't know. You can type more than one question mark in a word. But the more question marks you type, the more matches the Spanish Master finds.*

1. Type “ver?o??os?”  
at “ENTER a word in Spanish.”
2. Press **ENTER**.



vergonzoso  
vergonzosa

3. Highlight the word you want.
4. Press **ENTER** to view its definition.
5. Press **CLEAR** when done.

#### ✓ Zooming Through Text

To zoom to the bottom of a menu, list, or definition, hold **○** and press **↓**.

To zoom to the top of a menu, list, or definition, hold **○** and press **↑**.

## Using the Dictionary

---

### Finding Letters in Words

The asterisk key (\*) is similar to the question mark key in that it finds the matches of unknown words. However, it stands for any number of letters in a word. Try this example.

#### 1. Type “ver\*os\*” at “ENTER a word in Spanish.”

To type an asterisk, hold **SHIFT** and press **?\***.

#### 2. Press **ENTER**.

```
Verbos  
verboso  
vergonzoso  
Versos  
verosimil
```

#### 3. Highlight the word you want.

#### 4. Press **ENTER** to view its definition.

#### 5. Press **CLEAR** when done.

### ✓ Accenting Letters

At Entry screens, you can accent letters by typing the letter and then pressing **↑** or **ACNT** repeatedly until the correct accent appears. NOTE: You do not need to type accents when you are searching a menu.

# Using Other Features

## Viewing Inflections

Many words have inflections, such as the plural form of a noun or the present perfect form of a verb. You can view inflections of a word by pressing **MORE**. Make sure you're at the Spanish Entry screen to try these examples.

## Nouns

1. Type “gato” at “ENTER a word in Spanish.”
2. Press **MORE**.

```
gato  
gatos (plural)  
- (masculine)
```

3. Press **CLEAR** when done.

## Adjectives

1. Type “bonito” at “ENTER a word in Spanish.”
2. Press **MORE**.

You see two parts of speech for “bonito.”

3. Press **↓** to highlight the adjective.
4. Press **ENTER**.

```
bonito (masc. sing.)  
bonita (fem. sing.)  
bonitos (masc. pl.)  
bonitas (fem. pl.)
```

## Using Other Features

---

### Verbs

*Verbs have many inflections. Here's how to find them.*

1. Type “**estar**” at “**ENTER a word in Spanish.**”
2. Press **MORE** to view its principal parts.

```
yo estoy (today)
yo estare (tomorrow)
yo estuve, yo estaba (yesterday)
yo he estado (recently)
```

3. Press **MORE** again.

```
PRESENT INDICATIVE
yo estoy
tú estás
él está
nosotros estamos
```

These are present indicative forms of “**estar.**”

4. Press **↓** to scroll down.
5. Press **MORE** repeatedly to view more inflections.
6. Press **CLEAR** when done.

### ✓ **Getting Help within Inflections**

Press **HELP** to read extensive information about the inflection you are viewing. It will show the definition of that particular inflected form and give examples of how the inflection is used in Spanish and English. In this way you can be sure of your word choice.

### ✓ **Getting More From Your User Lists**

You can view definitions and inflections directly from a User List by highlighting the word you want to see and pressing **MORE**.

### Using the User Lists

*The Spanish Master lets you create your own word lists. For example, you can create a vocabulary list for school or a list of words with which to play the games.*

*There is an English User List and a Spanish User List. You can store up to 20 words in total. NOTE: Your User Lists are erased when you remove the Spanish Master from the Digital Book System.*

### Adding a Word

1. Type “hombre” at “ENTER a word in Spanish.”
2. Press **LIST**.



```
View the Spanish List: ** Empty **
Add hombre
Delete a word
Erase the list
```

3. Highlight “Add *hombre*.”
4. Press **ENTER** to add the word.
5. Highlight “View the Spanish List: 1 word.”
6. Press **ENTER** to view the Spanish list.
7. Press **CLEAR** when done.

## Using Other Features

---


*You can delete a single word in a User List or erase the entire list.*

### Deleting a Word

1. Press **LIST**.
2. Press **↓** to highlight “Delete a word.”
3. Press **ENTER**.
4. Highlight a word in the User List.
5. Press **ENTER** to delete it.
6. Press **CLEAR** when done.

### Deleting a List

1. Press **LIST**.
2. Press **↓** to highlight “Erase the list.”
3. Press **ENTER**.



```
View the Spanish List: 1 word
Add a word
Del/Erase the word list (Y/N)?
Erase one word
```

4. Press Y for yes.

#### ✓ Adding Highlighted Words

You can also add words to a User List by highlighting them in definitions or correction lists. Then follow steps 2-7 on page 22.



# Games

*The Spanish Master has many fun and educational games. You should select game settings to customize the games before you play.*

## Selecting Game Settings

1. Press **MENU**.
2. Select **“Game Settings”** under the **Other** menu.

The Words, Skill, Inflect, and Language menus appear. To select a setting, highlight it under a menu and then press **ENTER**. Your selection is marked with a check.

### Words

This menu lets you choose the complexity of the words you want to play games with. NOTE: You must have words in a User List to use the User List setting. TOEFL stands for Test of English as a Foreign Language.

### Skill

You can also choose the skill level of the games.

### Inflect

Here you choose between using root words only or using inflected forms.

### Language

Choose to play with English or Spanish words.

### Selecting a Game

1. Press **GAMES**.
2. Highlight a game.
3. Press **ENTER** to start playing.

### Hangman

You have five to nine guesses (#) at the mystery word (?) depending on the skill level. Type letters you think might be in the mystery word. If you're correct, they will take the place of the corresponding "?". If you guess the word, "You win!" and your man is free. If you don't, "Sorry, you lost", your man gets hanged. Your score will appear after each game. Press **SPACE** to continue. Press **BACK** to select a new game or return from a definition.

### Word Auction

You start with an amount of money determined by the skill level you chose. Beginners start with more money than Wizards. Each letter costs money. The more frequent the letter, the more it costs. Each letter that you type, whether you're right or wrong, will cost you money. To buy a letter for \$25 plus the cost of the letter given, press \*. If you guess the word, the cash you have left will be added to the starting money of the next round. Press **ENTER** for the definition, or **SPACE** to continue.

### Word Blaster

Word Blaster is a speed spelling game. The speed is determined by the skill level. The question marks represent a word. Letters will randomly appear uncovering the question marks. Press **ENTER** when you think that you know the word. Then type the answer, and press **ENTER**. If you're wrong, you can either try again, press "?" for the answer, or press \* for a quick peek. If you're correct, you win! Your score will flash on the screen after each round. Press **SPACE** to continue.

### Flashcards

Flashcards flashes words on the screen for you to define or spell. If you'd like to view the definitions of the word, press **ENTER**. Press **BACK** to return to Flashcards. If you don't want to find the definition, press **SPACE** to continue viewing words.

### Word Train

All aboard the Word Train spelling game! This game is played between you and the Spanish Master. You take turns typing letters to form a word. The first to spell the word wins. Some abbreviations will be accepted such as "YMCA." Press **SPACE** to continue, or **ENTER** for the definition. Press **BACK** to return to Word Train.

*NOTE: The following two games use Spanish words only.*

### **Gender Tutor**

This game quizzes you on the gender of the Spanish word. Type “m” if the word is masculine, or “f” if the word is feminine. The Spanish Master gives you a time limit for your answer. Beginners get more time than Wizards. Press **ENTER** to view the definition. Press **SPACE** to continue.

### **Conjumania**

This game quizzes you on the conjugation of Spanish verbs. You will see an infinitive and the inflection wanted. Type the answer. If you don't know the answer, press **?\*** to see it. Press **ENTER** for the definition; press **BACK** to return to Conjumania. Press **SPACE** to continue.

#### **✓ Help with Games**

If you find you need help while playing a game, press **HELP**. Then press **↓** to scroll down. Press **BACK** to return to the game.

# Appendixes

*This section reviews key features of the Digital Book System.*

## **Sending Words Between Books**

*The Spanish Master can send and receive words from certain other digital books.*

### **1. Highlight a word in a digital book.**

Read its User's Manual to learn how.

### **2. Hold and press .**

### **3. Press or to highlight the other digital book symbol.**

### **4. Press .**

The initial screen of the book that you selected appears with your word in it.

### **5. Press again, if needed, to look up the word.**

### Replacing the Batteries

*The DBS-1 and DBS-2 use four 3-volt, CR2032 lithium batteries. The DBS-2D uses four 1.5-volt, AA batteries.*

- 1. Have new batteries ready.**
- 2. Turn the Digital Book System off.**
- 3. Slide the battery cover off the back.**
- 4. Remove all the batteries.**
- 5. Place new batteries in the cavities, with the +’s oriented correctly. (In the DBS-1 and DBS-2, the +’s should face up.)**
- 6. Replace the battery cover.**

#### ✓ **Battery Precautions**

When you replace batteries, follow these precautions to avoid erasing information on your installed digital books:

- Replace the batteries before they lose power;
- Once batteries have been removed, install new ones within two minutes;
- Don’t mix old and new batteries;
- Never remove batteries with the unit on.

### Resetting the Digital Book System

To reset the Digital Book System, hold **CLEAR** while pressing **ON/OFF**. Or press the recessed reset button on the back of the Digital Book System. (Read its Basic Operating Guide for details.)

**WARNING:** Resetting the Digital Book System may permanently erase information, such as notes, that you have entered in the installed digital books.

**NOTE:** If the keyboard fails to respond or the screen performs erratically, you can press **CLEAR** and then press **ON/OFF** rather than resetting the Digital Book System. If nothing happens, then reset.

### Protecting and Cleaning

- Do not touch the metal contacts on the back of digital books or the rubber contacts on the Digital Book System with statically charged objects. Statically charged objects may erase information that you entered in the digital books.
- Do not put excessive weight on digital books or the Digital Book System, or expose them to extreme or prolonged heat, cold, or other adverse conditions.
- To clean digital books, apply isopropyl alcohol with cotton swab. To clean the Digital Book System, apply a mild household cleaner with a soft cloth.  
**CAUTION:** Spraying liquids on digital books or the Digital Book System may damage them.
